Born: June 10, 1930 to Francis Vaughn Tobin and Nora (Kelly) in Maryville, Missouri

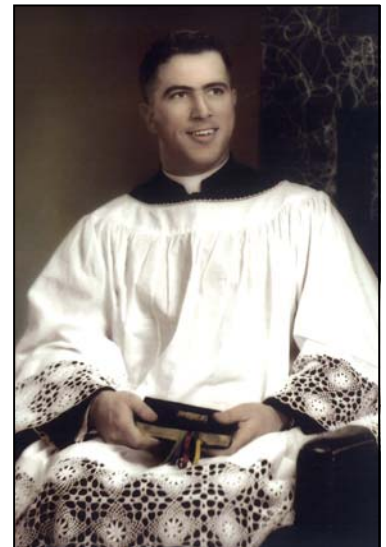
Ordained: March 17, 1956 at St. Patrick's Church, Maryville, Missouri
